ROCKY KNOB TRAIL

This lovely little trail is maintained by the Forest Service, Bureau of Forestry, Department of Environmental Resources, in the MICHAUX STATE FOREST.

To reach the area, approach on the Shippensburg--Arendtsville Road, turning onto the Ridge Road, toward Fayetteville.

In just over 2 miles, you will find signs plainly marking where the Trail head is.

The circle made by the Rocky Knob Trail is 3.90 miles.

At about .17 m cross the Appalachian Trail; At .42 m bear to the left on the Trail, following it over Sier Hill, around Rocky Knob, and descending to an old logging road, at 2.58 m. Follow the old logging road back to junction with trail we came in on, at 3.48 m. Another .42 m brings you back to your cars. Total 3.90 m.

Map scale is 2.625 inches to the mile.
