

OUR FAVORITE HIKES - No 20 — RELOCATED SECTION OF THE HORSE-SHOE TRAIL - PART I OF 4

Part 1 takes you from the Manada Bottom Road, in Manada Gap to juncture with State Route 443.

Originally, when the Appalachian Trail followed Blue Mountain to the Esquehanna River at Rock Hill, the Horse-shoe Trail functioned with the Appalachian Trail along the Manada Bottom Road.

After the Trail Relocation Project in 1954, this section of the Horse-shoe Trail was put through to, again, junction with the Appalachian Trail. This is the Horse-shoe Trail indicated to the right. It was later relocated west; then relocated through Cold Springs, and now re-located again to the present route.
