

NOTICE

This hike is on private property, belonging to the Tumbling Run Game Club. Permission is required to do this hike. Our contact has always been Frank Masland.

The hike starts where the Pine Grove Furnace--Caladonia Road crosses from Cumberland to Adams County.

- Parking area at the County Line..... 0.00 m
- Cross Tumbling Run..... 0.14 m
- Foot trail slashes left from old wood road..... 0.38 m
- Follow stream to base of Lewis Rocks 0.71 m
- Climb around on Lewis Rocks, which adds to the total mileage.
- Leave Lewis Rocks at about..... 0.86 m.
- Walk along edge of Lewis Rocks, reaching old wood road..... 1.14 m
- Turn right on old wood road, reaching junction with foot trail..... 3.33 m
- Reach crossing of Tumbling Run..... 3.67 m
- Reach parking area..... 3.90 m

To this should be added any mileage spent on the Rocks.

LEWIS ROCKS

These rocks were supposedly a hide-out of Lewis the Robber, who hid in the caves here. The caves are formed by high overhanging rocks, rather than the conventional caves. However, cave rats and cave crickets are to be found amongst the rocks.

One time, we did find a large room formed by an overhanging rock, but have not been able to find it again. This apparently is the reason, it made a good hide-out for Robert Lewis. Lewis was eventually captured and died in prison in Lewistown, PA.
